1. Executive Summary

Sacred Humboldt is a regenerative healing center and herb farm located in Humboldt County, California. Our mission is to provide individuals with accessible tools for physical, emotional, and spiritual healing through a fusion of ancient practices, frequency-based healing technology, and herbal medicine.

Operating across two core sites—our farm and healing center in Honeydew and a leased storefront in downtown Eureka—Sacred Humboldt offers plant-based healing products, wellness technology access, and educational programs. The Sacred mobile app in development complements our physical offerings by helping users identify herbal and energetic solutions based on their symptoms.

The retail space will allow for in person healing sessions, both self guided and professionally guided, access to healing tools and education, sales of herbs, water and other metaphysical tools, access to healing hot tubs and will serve as a funnel to deeper healing retreats on the farm.

The farm will grow many of the herbs used in the retail space, as well as provide healing retreats for those who are ready to go deeper. This allows us to grow the plants we need to use in our healing work, knowing they were grown with the best possible energy, and cutting costs and providing additional income streams.

Humboldt County also serves as a major tourist destination for people seeking healing and sanctuary and both the healing center and farm in Honeydew offer exactly that. Tiny homes will be built on the farm property for visitors who want to retreat for a deeper healing experience.

2. Business Model

Sacred Humboldt operates under a hybrid model of physical services, product sales, and digital wellness access. Revenue is generated through:

- Herbal product sales (on-site, online, farmers markets and wholesale)
- Healing sessions (self-guided with BEMER, Healy, Rife)
- Retreats, workshops, and events
- Membership subscriptions
- Sacred app access and referrals
- Retail sales of water systems, crystals, tools, and metaphysical products
- Hot tub sessions

3. Core Offerings

- Herbal Products: Tinctures, teas, balms, powders, and customized blends
- Energy Healing Tools: Rife, BEMER, Healy (self-assisted model with optional guidance)
- Healing sessions- QHHT (quantum healing hypnosis technique), sound healing, EFT tapping, massage, Reiki
- Retreats & Workshops: Plant medicine education, energy healing, regenerative farming,
 QHHT, sound healing water float events on the river
- Membership Packages: Details outlined in Section 6
- Sacred App: Symptom-to-herb lookup with spiritual/energetic integration
- Water Services: Ionized pH-balanced refills and home system sales (Alkaviva partnership)
- Retail Store: Herbs, energy tools, spiritual supplies, books, crystals
- Healing hot tubs purified alkaline water hot tub soaking sessions to amplify healing and provide respite and relief from pain and stress

8. Funding Strategy

We will seek a combination of USDA grants, veteran wellness funding, private investors, and loans. Our rental-first strategy reduces capital requirements and allows us to demonstrate early success before scaling to permanent infrastructure or land ownership.

9. Vision & Healing Philosophy

Sacred Humboldt was created in response to a collective need for real healing—beyond pharmaceuticals, beyond disconnection from land, and beyond commodified wellness trends. We believe true healing is a remembrance—of what the body can do, of what the Earth provides, and of what the spirit holds.

We fuse indigenous herbal wisdom, frequency-based technologies, and self-empowerment tools to reconnect people with their ability to heal themselves. Our approach is sovereign, trauma-informed, and spiritually inclusive. We are not offering fixes—we are offering tools, spaces, and sacred experiences that help people remember who they are and allow them to learn how to heal their own bodies. Different healing tools resonate for different people and Sacred Humboldt aims to offer as many different healing tools as possible to help as many people as possible.

This philosophy guides everything we grow, build, and teach. From the crystal-lined meditation rooms to the hot tubs under the redwoods, every detail is designed to restore connection—to nature, to body, to Source.

10. Community Impact & Goals

Sacred Humboldt aims to become a hub for healing, education, and economic regeneration in Humboldt County. Our project supports the local economy by sourcing materials and talent locally, offering healing jobs to veterans and alternative practitioners, and bringing tourism revenue to the area.

Our long-term goals include:

Hosting monthly community healing events with free access for low-income participants

- Establishing a nonprofit branch to fund QHHT sessions and trauma release services for veterans and marginalized communities
- Launching a Sacred Herbalist Apprenticeship to train local youth in regenerative farming and herbal medicine
- Developing a land-based healing model that can be replicated in other rural communities

Our space will be accessible but sacred, profitable but purpose-driven, and expansive while remaining grounded in nature's rhythms.

11. Marketing & Outreach Strategy

Our outreach combines digital presence with real-life connection.

- Digital Content: TikTok and YouTube storytelling featuring "Happy" the off-grid regenerative farmer and healer. SEO-optimized herbal blog and video content. Weekly email sequences based on seasonal herbs and healing tools.
- Community Engagement: Local herb festivals, veteran-specific healing events, collaboration with Humboldt healers and artists, and discounted services for community members in need.
- Partnerships & Influencers: Align with wellness influencers, spiritual guides, and holistic medicine educators to expand reach, secure podcast features, and drive targeted traffic to our app and retreat offerings.

We intend to launch Sacred Chicago, Sacred San Francisco, Sacred Austin, Sacred Phoenix, Sacred Boston, and more, with the farm and healing center in Humboldt being our home base and main supplier.
